Saturday, the trade floor opens at 7:30 to those who have registered and to the public at 9:00.

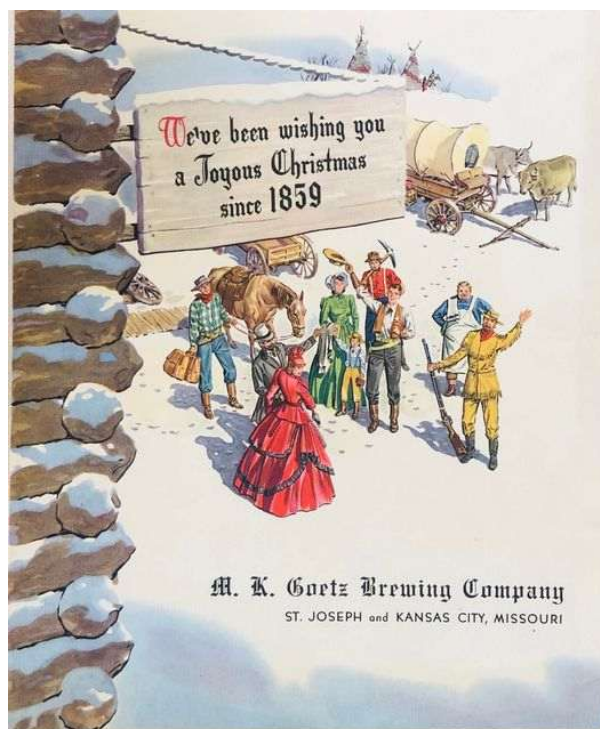
Activities will then continue Saturday night with the hospitality suite again open and still stocked with those fine ales.

## BAXTER SPRINGS BREWERY

The Zelleken Brewery, also known as the Baxter Springs brewery. Erected in 1870 by Edward Zelleken. The building was constructed of brick and yellow sandstone. After the Kansas cattle boom diminished, Zelleken abandoned the building, moved to Joplin, and made a fortune in the mining business. Years later, the building was purchased by Charles F. Parham and it became his home, headquarters for the Apostolic Faith Mission and the printing press location for the periodical newspaper entitled The Apostolic Faith. In the early 1960's, the building was condemned and razed.



### **Boulevard will jump into THC-infused drinks with a version of Quirk called Berry Jane**

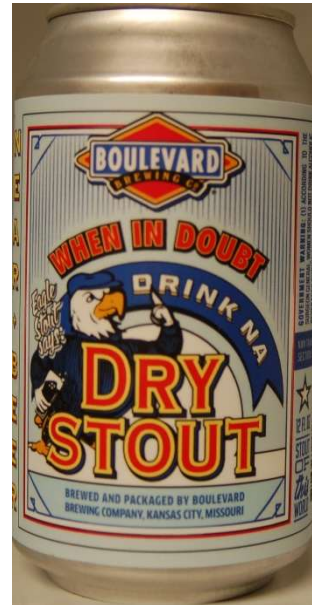
Boulevard Brewing aims to lead the market for THC-infused beverages in Kansas and Missouri, starting with the October release of a hard seltzer called Berry Jane.

## MORE KC BREWERIES CLOSED THAN OPENED IN 2025.

The doors are locked to the rectangular brick building in Kansas City's Crossroads district. They have been since March, when Double Shift Brewing Co. — situated in an area dubbed Brewer's Alley — said goodbye to its fans of 10 years and filled its last chalice.

Its departure left a hole in the beer-loving block and saddened longtime customers. But unfortunately for the local craft brewing industry, it wouldn't be the last closure in the metro. Pathlight in Shawnee, Crane in Raytown, Boho in Parkville, The Big Rip in North Kansas City and Dubious Claims in Excelsior Springs have all shut down this year. Grains & Taps has closed its downtown Lee's Summit tasting room, though it still remains open on Blue Parkway. Not a catastrophic amount of businesses, but unusual enough to catch the attention of beer drinkers and brewery operators. Many breweries that remain also told The Star that 2025 saw lower beer sales than years past.



Stockyards added the above cans to their growing inventory of available ales. Hazies Grow up to be Cowboys is a double dry hopped hazy IPA and Strawburied Alive is a sour with strawberry and lemon.

## CRAFT BEER CHALLENGES

The craft beer apocalypse over the last three years has claimed dozens of breweries, forcing many brewers to file for bankruptcy protection and, in some cases, shut down their businesses. Brewery closings outpaced openings in June 2025, declining 1% to 9,269 breweries from 9,352 in June 2024, according to the Brewers Association's 2025 Midyear Market Report.

The business closing trend followed the previous year's downturn, when operating craft breweries declined nationwide to 9,680 in 2024, down from 9,747 in 2023

The decline in 2024 was the fourth consecutive year that the number of new brewery openings declined, with 434 new breweries opening and 501 closing last year, according to the report.

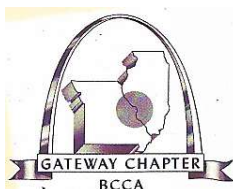
